Over the years he has also served on the Small Game Committee, ran the Tilapia Jamboree, raised thousands of dollars for the Legislative Defense Fund, is a Regular Member of the Big Game Club with 7 different big game species, is a committee member of the DFW Big Game Budget Advisory Committee and Upland Game BAC, he is a BGC measurer, CBH/SAA State Field Champion and is a committee member of Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.
