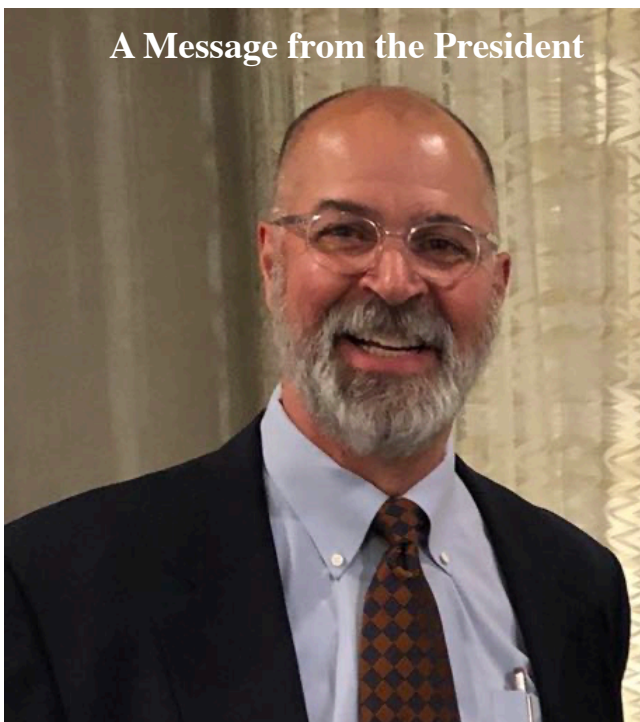

Hopefully, everyone has a few things they can use. I sincerely hope that most folks shopped for their archery and hunting gear at their local archery pro shops! You can find a list of all the California archery pro shops on the CBH/SAA website, and we are proud to have them as supporters. Each of them has a full line of the latest equipment and the expertise to set it up for you. Give them a look first for all your archery needs.

We have a few state tournaments coming up so please check the schedule in this newsletter or the website (look for updates) and don't miss out. State Indoor should be underway, and you have quite a few venues from which to choose. Call the shop or venue for a time and date if it's not listed. want anyone to get penalized. Best of luck to anyone who is headed to Arizona and surrounding states, as there is always hunting to be done. I know some have been successful with out-of-state draws. If you are looking for alternatives out of state due to lack of success here in California, then contact your local CBH reps or anyone in the BGC or Leg Team. They will be happy to explain deadlines and costs for many of the surrounding states.



Please plan ahead in 2025. Keep in mind that Hunter Education is "in-person" going forward. There is no more online Hunter Ed here in California. If you or junior need a certificate to buy a hunting license and get in on the draw—plan ahead. Classes are a bit more limited than in the past and Bowhunter Ed is definitely more limited. Don't wait till a week before your trip and find out you can't buy what you need or that

junior didn't pass and now, you're stuck. It makes for a lot of aggravation.

I want to take a minute and say how pleased I am with the Leg Team and their accomplishments in 2024 and preparing for 2025. Amanda and her team have been instrumental in securing a proposal for additional Archery Elk Tags for the bowhunting community. They are working closely with the department on some F&G code changes for 2025 related to bears and the carrying of firearms during deer season. CBH Legislative Committee Update

Happy Holidays CBH/SAA Friends and Family!

The **2024 State Unmarked 3D Championship** is in the books! It was a georgeous weekend at Oranco Bowmen and I would like to thank again all of the volunteers and participants that made this trournament a success. We had 141 archers compete for the championship titles and thanks to the generosity of our raffle donors, together we raised \$5,150 for the CBH Legislative Defense Fund! Congratulations to the winners! Please support our partners that donated to the raffle including:

Turner's Outdoorsman and Riverside Archery, PSE, Willow Creek Archery, Archery Republic, Victory Archery, Morrell Targets, OnX Maps, Vortex Optics, and Ramrods.

A couple of **IMPORTANT** legislative actions to note this month:

First, CBH and other non-profit members of the California Hunting & Conservation Coalition (CHCC) are partnering with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) on a free raffle to encourage hunters to help in the fight against Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) in our state. See the flyer in this newsletter for more information on how to collect and [submit your deer/elk harvest CWD samples](#) and [enter the free raffle drawing](#).

Also, on Novemebr 12, members of the CBH Legislative Committee met with CDFW to review our collective CHCC comments on the **Draft Black Bear Conservation and Management Plan (Bear Plan)** and get CDFW feedback on how they plan to address those comments in the final document. Here are a few highlights:

- Concern raised about the lack of criteria for measuring successful bear management with respect to other species health, ecosystem health, sustainable population size, disease, carrying capacity benchmark, etc. CDFW noted a general lack of data in this area. A bear collaring program is in progress to gather more data for future modeling. This is a work in progress and the purpose of the Bear Plan is to provide a foundation for future management decisions.

In closing, I would like to call out a problem that I keep hearing about, and I hope we can all work through it. We seem to hear more and more clubs complaining about clubs or organizations "stepping on" other club's shoots. The archery landscape is changing in this country, and it seems with increasing popularity comes overcrowding and the griping that is sure to follow. With the advent of electronic media, it is easier than ever to advertise and get the word out about an archery event. As such, we are seeing more and more big-ticket archery events in every state. Our own sanctioning body (NFAA) is just as guilty as any of the others. I would never suggest that we NOT support an archery event as that is the way to new shooters and growth in the sport; I would, however, ask that we all look closely at the calendar before starting anything new. I am all for growth, but "splitting the baby," so to speak, is not how I would do it. I know the NorCal regions are doing a good job mediating between clubs and trying to ensure every club, big or small, is getting a fair chance at premium "tournament season" weekends. Let's all try to commit to talking with other clubs in the region before "stepping on" someone else's money-making shoot.

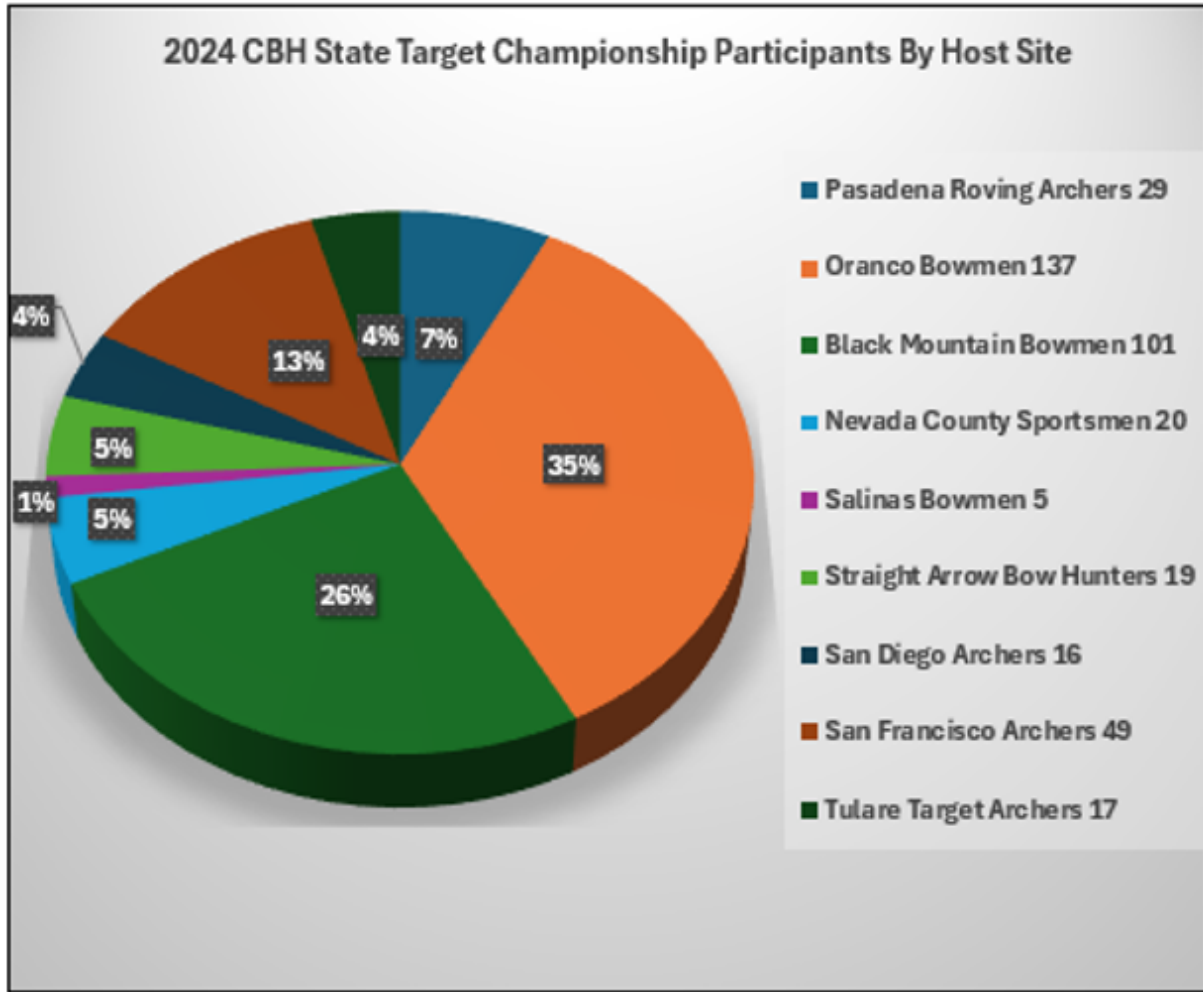

I would like to ask everyone as a CBH/SAA member to get involved in these programs. Whether it is Scouts, Royal Rangers, American Girls, or your local Youth Foundation, please get involved and help out. It's only a few hours and definitely helps grow archery and outdoor sports as a whole. It doesn't take a bunch of certifications to show a kid how to hold a bow and fling 4 or 5 arrows down range. It's rewarding and can really help the next generation get started.

CBH Legislative Committee Update from pg 4-

- Concern raised about the need for more modern studies and technologies. CDFW noted that Integrated Population Model (IPM) has been further strengthened with four additional studies and one study has been replaced following publication of the draft Bear Plan in April 2024. More than a dozen current studies are cited within the Bear Plan and annual updates are expected as addition studies are concluded and newer technologies tested (e.g., DNE methylation estimate age).
- Concern raised that the Bear Plan appears to be blaming Human Black Bear Conflict (HBC) issues on climate change and fires. CDFW committed to expanding Section 3.9 of the Bear Plan underscoring influence of attractants and expanding human and black bear populations.
- Concern raised that "animal welfare" should not be extended to hunting. CDFW notes that "animal welfare" is a goal of the plan and that hunter ethics covered within Section 3.6 but the Bear Plan does not define what is ethical.
- Request that CDFW provide harvest numbers in other states. CDFW added a table of harvest, population size, and regulations for all 34 US States. California stands out as having a very large bear population with low harvest rates.
- Concern raised that there is a large backlog of bear harvest tooth data. CDFW noted that data for the 2023 harvest season will be posted online in early 2025. Data from 2021-2023 will be posted online concurrent with the final Bear Plan. Tooth data takes slightly over a year to process and CDFW is working on ways to provide hunters feedback on the data related to their harvest.
- Concerns were raised that the Bear Plan needs clearer processes for determining Conflict, Depredation, and Public Safety Bears. CDFW noted that this information is provided in [Black Bear Policy in California](#) (2024) and CDFW web pages on human-wildlife interactions. The Bear Plan points to the Policy.
- CHCC advocated for hunting as a management tool to reduce human-bear conflict. CDFW committed to add more discussion of this Section 3.6 and 3.9. They again noted that the Black Bear Policy (2024) defines CDFW approach to human-black bear conflict and that **hunter harvest is too low to be effective.**
- Concern raised that more public education is needed to prevent human-black bear conflict. CDFW is a member of BearWise and provides online and in-person resources for coexistence.
- Request to increase citizen science and public involvement. CDFW will reach out to various organizations including American Bear Foundation (ABF) to increase citizen science and volunteer opportunities. Also, look for [advanced hunter ed webinars](#) related to bear hunting including: December 10, 2024: Webinar – Bear Hunting.
- Concern raised that the Bear Plan places too much emphasis on public perception of bear hunting. CDFW noted that FGC 1801 establishes a state wildlife policy that includes perpetuating species for intrinsic and ecological value, and for direct benefits to all persons. CDFW seeks to balance those in the Bear Plan.

- Question asked about how will CDFW recruit new black bear hunters? CDFW will add information about Junior Resident Bear Tags and additional context about R3 program to the Bear Plan. Some of these strategies are being developed internally (e.g., survey of hunters) at CDFW.

The final Bear Plan is expected in early 2025. CBH and our partners in the CHCC will work closely with CDFW and the Fish and Game Commission (FGC) to propose updates to bear hunting regulations that advance bear hunting opportunities within the context and science presented in the plan. The CBH Legislative Committee plans to commemorate these efforts on our **new 2025 collectable challenge coin** (coming soon)! Challenge coins are provided to clubs, regions, individuals, and other partners as a thank you for supporting the CBH Legislative Defense Fund (e.g., cumulative annual donation of \$100 or more).

Reminder: Whether you have been involved in archery or hunting your whole life, or are new to this sport, **you have something of value to add to the conversation and I encourage you to reach out to me and the CBH Legislative Committee to share your knowledge and experience!** We look forward to hearing from you soon!

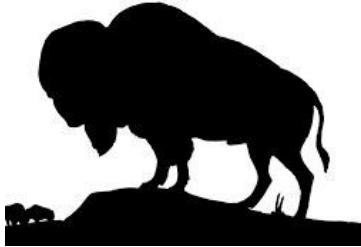

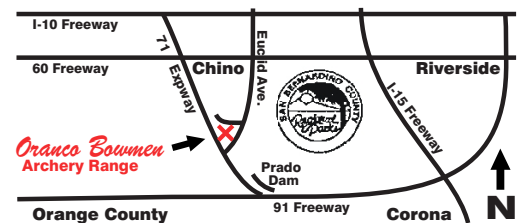



CBH/SAA State Broadhead Championship Tournament General Working Mechanics

1. This tournament is designed to appeal to the bowhunter. It is designed to offer the Archer the benefits of using their hunting equipment in a tournament. **NFAA rules do not apply to this event.**
2. The State Broadhead Tournament shall be a one or two day event held on Memorial Day weekend.
3. The 2nd Vice President of Hunting or his delegate shall govern this tournament.
4. The range for this event shall be laid in such a manner as to simulate hunting conditions when possible.
5. Archers must use hunting Broadheads for this event which is keeping with California State Fish & Game Laws on Big Game Hunting.
 - A. Scoring:
 - 1) Vital—10 Kill-8 Wound-5
 - 2) An arrow must be in the target to score, except a “pass-through” which must be witnessed and scored as witnessed by other shooters in the group.
 - 3) “Bounce-ins and Glance-offs” shall not score.
 - 4) “Antlers” do not score.
 - 5) Shaft of arrow must touch the line for higher score.
 - 6) Double scoring is required.
 - 7) This shall be a one-arrow tournament at unmarked yardages.
 - B. Divisions and Styles of Shooting:
 - 1) Divisions
 - a) Seniors (65+)
 - b) Adult (18-64):
 - c) Junior (12-17):
 - 2) Styles:
 - a) Sight Fingers (SF) Compound/Recurve
 - b) Non-Sight (NS)
 - c) Bowhunter Release (BR) up to 7 fixed pin, Max 12” Stab Front, Backbar OK.
 - d) Hunter Release (HR) Bow must be camo or matt finish, Quiver must be attached to bow, Any sight ok, No stabilizer restriction
 - e) Recurve (No Sight) (RC)
 - f) Longbow (No Sight) (L)
 - g) Junior Class will be Sights/Non Sights
 - C. Awards:
 - 1) CBH/SAA Membership (Regular or Associate) is required to compete for awards.
 - 2) Guest Class is one Class (Male and Female combined) and there will be no awards.
 - 3) No awards will be mailed.
 - 4) Cubs and Peewees Participation Awards Only
 - D. Tackle
 - 1) Mechanical Broadheads must be operational
 - 2) 12” stabilizer restriction on Bowhunter Release Class Only.
 - 3) Bow Quivers are allowed in all styles.
 - 4) No magnifying scopes are allowed.
 - 5) No compound over 80 pounds peak draw weight. Recurves and longbows have no weight limit.
 - E. Miscellaneous:
 - 1) Cubs and Peewees will shoot field points only
 - 2) Parents will be responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.
 - 3) All protests to the Protest Committee will be in writing within thirty (20) minutes of the end of the tournament each day and include a \$25 fee which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
 - 4) There must be a minimum of three shooters per target at all times.
 - 5) Top shooters from each style will be grouped on the 2nd day of the tournament. Cubs and Peewees will not be allowed to shoot in top flight groups. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - 6) **NO TARGET OR SIGHT NOTES ALLOWED (SIGHT TAPES OK)**
 - 7) No discussion of yardage prior to shooting. Discussions afterwards must be done in a manner to ensure that other archers who haven’t shot will be assisted .
 - 8) No one is allowed on the tournament course before or after the tournament shooting hours except for tournament officials
 - 9) Spectators will only be allowed with unanimous approval of the group.
 - 10) Rule violations can result in disqualification.
 - 11) Cell phones allowed, pictures and promotion on social media encouraged.
 - 12) Tournament officials will have communication devices for emergencies and range duties.
 - 13) Unsportsmanlike conduct can result in disqualifications.
- 6) **NO RANGE FINDING DEVICES ALLOWED!!**
- 7) Broadheads must be dulled and meet Fish & Game Codes at all times during the shoot.
- 8) Practice blades are allowed if they meet Fish & Game Codes (7/8 minimum diameter)
- 9) Broadheads may be subject to size testing at any time during the tournament.
- 10) All bows shall be limited to 300 fps with a 3% tolerance for differences in chronographs.
- 11) Arrow speed may be checked anytime during the tournament.
- 12) Longbows: any type of arrow shaft is allowed.
- 13) Longbows: will be shot off the shelf
- 14) Clickers allowed in all styles.
- 15) All bows and broadheads must be inspected on Saturday morning.
