Mike Wysock and Bruce Graham started The Bow Rack back in March of 1987. Mike kept working as a wholesale salesman for sporting goods, for a while, and Bruce was at the shop working on the bows. They knew there was a need for their services in the Northern California area and they jumped in. They soon built up a loyal clientele.

Mike and Bruce would both shoot at the local tournaments, but it was Mike that would compete at another level. He made numerous trips to the “Vegas Shoot”, competed at the Western Classic Trail Shoot in Redding and was a CBH/SAA State Champion for Indoor, multiple times.

In 2018, Matt Beller and Mike’s son, Anthony, stepped in when Bruce retired and they ended up moving the shop to where it is located today (928 Cypress Ave., Redding).

The Bow Rack is one of the top tiered PSE dealers and held that title for many years. They will work on all types of bows from compound to the traditional style, hunting and target styles, along with selling bows for Hoyt, Bow Tech, Mathews, Elite and Bear. And, of course, they have the bow accessories and clothing to go along with it. They also have held the State Indoor, many years over and continue to this day. Their clientele ranges from the beginner, young to old, the “every once in a while” archer to the advanced. They have worked with world champion and record setting archers and hunters of all ages and knowledge.

Matt Beller is a Veteran. He became disabled while serving in the Marine Corp. He has competed in the Arizona Cup for the Para Olympics and has competed locally. You can find Matt at the shop, greeting you with a hello and a smile, while building arrows.

Anthony is no stranger to archery hunting. He still holds the record in the Big Game Club for the Typical Blacktail Deer taken in August 2006 and scored a 157 0/8. He and Mike will travel out of state just about every year to go hunting.

They have been very supportive of the archery community and we are lucky to have them as a local pro shop. If you are in the area, stop in and say “hello” and maybe drop a couple bucks with them.

## Legislative Team Update

Hello CBH/SAA friends and family!

Although the 2021/2022 State Legislature session is concluded, the drama surrounding **AB 2571 Firearms: Advertising to Minors** continues! I am pleased to announce that “clean-up” legislation in the form of AB 160 passed through the legislature on August 30, 2022. However, the Governor is taking his sweet time in signing it into law... the deadline is three days away on September 30!

If AB 160 is signed, it will provide immediate relief for NGOs like CBH/SAA and will allow our California Hunting and Conservation Coalition (CHCC) partner California Rifle and Pistol Association (CRPA) to move forward with their lawsuit to permanently defeat this new law. Check out <https://crpa.org/> for the latest updates.

Our efforts to promote conservation and protect hunting opportunities with California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) and the California Fish and Game Commission continue. At the September Wildlife Resource Committee (WRC) meeting, CDFW presented a proposal aimed at protecting California deer and elk (cervids) from the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD). The proposal included updates to California Code of Regulations, Title 14 to:

- Include moose, caribou, reindeer, and other Cervidae in the hunter-harvest carcass importation regulations (Title 14 Section 712) and language to clarify parts that can be imported.
- Provide clear regulations limiting possession, importation, and transportation of live cervids (Family Cervidae).
- **Restrict biological (e.g., urine-based) attractants or scent lures.**

While CBH/SAA recognizes the critical threat CWD poses to California deer and elk populations, we want to ensure that recommendations and subsequent actions by CDFW are founded on science. CBH/SAA and our partners in the CHCC including California Deer Association (CDA) and Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation (RMEF) question the need to ban scent-based lures for cervid hunting in California. We believe that these products, many of which undergo rigorous testing and regulation, present a very limited threat to the spread of CWD in California. However, more stakeholder outreach and research are needed.

In a recent letter, CBH/SAA urged CDFW to perform independent research and analysis on the risks of CWD spread through scent-based lures. Specifically, we asked CDFW to address the following questions at or before the next WRC meeting in January 2023:

- What aspects of wildlife management, environmental factors, current spread of CWD, captive cervid management, prevalence of scent-based lure use, etc. played a role in other State’s decisions to ban/partly ban scent-based lures? Do these conditions exist in California? To what extent?
- How many scent-based lures are sold and/or used in California (versus taken out of state) by hunters and wildlife photographers?
- How would CDFW enforce a full or partial ban of scent-based lures for cervid hunting and wildlife photography?
- What is the opportunity cost of scent-based lure ban and enforcement? Are there other preventative methods that would provide better value for time, resources, cost being spent on this effort (e.g., more public/hunter education and CWD testing)?
- What is the efficacy of commercial product testing methods and other industry regulatory controls for herd management? Continued on page 10

## BIG GAME CLUB TRAILER

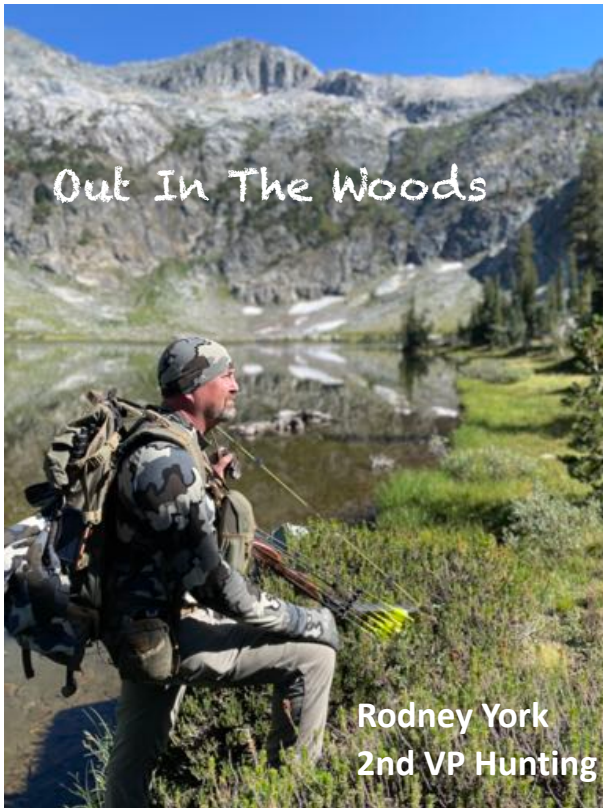

## the "Little Things"

When packing for a wilderness hunt of five or more days there are many essential items needed to be prepared for a safe and enjoyable excursion. An interested person can locate a diversity of articles and/or lists detailing the "main" commodities based on the hunt.

The length of time dedicated to the cause of pursuing game of various types and the location of these said animals must also be considered. Our quest in this article is an attempt to highlight some items so simple one might not think to include them. Although "*little things*" they could surely make all the difference in your world afield. An example; your semi-annual visit to the dentist for a cleaning could prove profitable. The doctor may offer you a small (.75 oz.) tube of toothpaste which you normally decline. With a foreshadowing, you accept and decide to include the replacement head from your electric toothbrush at home. You envision both items fitting handily into your "med pouch"

taking up nearly no space and just the same amount of weight. The dental floss could also be handy, so you include that as well. Ibuprofen can be a life saver... not only for a fever or pain reducer, but also to assist in relaxing muscular aching from repeatedly over stretching and fatiguing far beyond daily expectations.

More essential meds will be easier to remember to pack, you add them to the list along with the *Blistex-Lip Medex* you know the high country demands.

You're off to a great start - planning ahead and begin your own list of items to procure. You realize how smart it will be to trim your finger and toe nails three days before departure. With almost the same brilliance you know you will need to book a Wilderness permit online. You place your National Park pass in the window of your vehicle in case you cross the mountain to east side access. Now you are ahead of the game in that you already placed your hunting license and tags in the top pouch of your pack. They are easy to get to and will keep you from the embarrassment of calling home to have them "over-night" delivered.

You continue your diligence by purchasing two new sets of shoe strings for your freshly waxed boots. You're on a roll now so you continue by changing out and replacing your watch, Garmin, headlamp and flashlight batteries.

A new bowstring is installed on your bow. You take time breaking it in and adjusting the tiller and brace height numerous times on the "non stretch" item. You make a note to yourself to wax the string the night before leaving and tuck an extra finger tab in to be safe.

Thinking of safety takes you to a whole new level as you start by rolling your H2O *Sawyer Squeeze* filter and laying it neatly into your "Med Pouch."

Now your thoughts shift to more items needed. For processing your meat in the field, experience has reminded you'll need 2) pairs of rubber gloves readily available for your protection. Cont page 9



The Little Things from page 9- Of course those will be worthless without your folding knife and replacement blades. You figure 3) game bags will be enough for the California “muledeer” you are about to tuck into your pack for the downward truck bound journey.



You plan to “wash-up” with the Handy Wipes you placed on top of the game bags. The 2) [five strand] parachute cords of 20’ and 30’ lengths will suffice to anchor all baggage in place.

By this time you are feeling pretty smug - “Oh shoot,” you say out loud as you grimace with the fact you have made no plan for your own survival - other than your tent and 15 degree down bag. “What about my space blanket,” you question. Then there is that “Old” Fletch-tite glue you know will start a fire on top of water, so you pack that and two BIC lighters for good measure.

Foods to include would be on any list for subsistence. Generally, costly freeze dried dishes would no doubt be included yet you have stumbled on other alternatives. The Dollar Store can replace those \$13 dollar dinners for a couple of bucks. You’ve discovered you can not only save money but satisfy your taste buds, and fill your belly.

Such selections as *Idaho Instant Potatoes*, of various flavors can be divided in two or even

three servings. Four Cheese, Loaded, Sour Cream N Chives, Baby Reds, Roasted Garlic, and Bacon Bits can be augmented with protein rich ingredients.

The 80 calorie *StarKist* tuna creations pouches (17g of protein), Indian lentils, black beans, sardines and jerky strips can be stirred into your meal adding nutritional delight. You have also learned these *StarKist* pouches can double as a serving dish or cup as needed - once again discarding unnecessary weight from your back the cup stays at home.

Probably also on your short list of snack foods would be such nibble treats as almonds and other high protein and fiber delicacies. Your sweet tooth need not go unattended either!



Places like *Costco* can yield *Kind* and *Cliff* bars and *Nature's Bakery* fig bars which withstand more heat than most desserts; but you realize M&M's are tough to beat -so you plan your trip to the store. Continued on page 31

You know there is never a “last” thing when planning an outing but you are conscious your back can only handle so much. Without reluctance you pack your *Petzl* headlamps knowing they are quite nearly irreplaceable for keeping both hands free for whatever the duties to perform.

Hands furthermore must be protected by some good leather gloves. Just one joisted poke by a stick or slash by a sharp rock can ruin your trip. Band aids are a must; if a thumb or forefinger is cut menial tasks become almost impossible to perform. Securing your walking stick, wrapped with 5 feet of electrical tape you determine you are ready. You know these “little things” *may* save your life; but you are certain they **WILL** make your “walk about” much more enjoyable.

## Band-Tailed Pigeons and Rock Pigeons

I'm sure most of you are aware of dove hunting and that there is not only Morning Dove you can harvest but there is also a white wing dove you can also hunt and harvest. Additionally, did you know there is a "Band-Tailed Pigeon" that you can also harvest under the similar laws of our Department of Fish and Wildlife. Band-Tails have a regulated season, it is usually in the middle of December, and it only last one week. So your window for harvesting one of these fast-flying critters is limited and your daily bag limit is only 2 per day and your possession is triple the daily bag limit. You can find these fast-flying Band-Tails at higher altitudes, mostly in the mountains, in treetops, and snuggling inside the pine trees hiding from predators. However, sometimes you can find them in the foothills of the high desert. The reason they are named Band-Tails is the distinctive and noticeable band across their tail feathers. Other differences from the rock pigeon is their yellow feet, yellow beak and they are about 20% larger than the rock pigeon. Also keep in mind these Band-Tailed pigeons are very tasty too.

Please note there is a northern California season and a southern season so make sure you check the DFW website at ... [wildlife.ca.gov](http://wildlife.ca.gov). for detailed information before your grab your bow.

The Rock Pigeon is another species you can harvest and add to your list of critters. They are dark and light grey in color. They are the same ones you have probably seen around dairies, feed lots, parks and maybe around your local grocery store. The rock pigeon doesn't have an established season, is considered a pest, a non-invasive species, with no limit and can be hunted all year. The Rock Pigeons you will find in the dairies and feedlots are the best for table fair.

Good luck and remember, chasing FINS, FEATHERS, and FUR is Fun for everyone.

## Easy Dove Poppers



Grilled dove poppers are simple to make with this recipe, plus you can easily modify the ingredients to suit your tastes.

**Yield:** 20 dove poppers

**Prep time:** 45 minutes

**Cook time:** 20 minutes

### Ingredients:

40 Cleaned Dove breasts  
2 Cans pickled jalapeños  
2-24-oz bottles of Kraft Zesty Italian Dressing  
1 Pound thinly sliced bacon  
Toothpicks

### Directions:

- 1-Cut sliced jalapeños into smaller pieces and set aside.
- 2-Place some jalapeños in between two dove breasts. Wrap one piece of bacon tightly around the two dove breasts; secure with a toothpick.
- 3-Repeat step 2 with remaining dove breasts.
4. Once all dove poppers are assembled, place them in a large bowl. Pour Italian dressing over poppers, making sure each one is covered in the dressing.
5. Cover the bowl of poppers with a lid or plastic wrap and place in refrigerator. Allow dove poppers to marinate in the refrigerator overnight.
6. Grill dove poppers for about 20 minutes over indirect heat, flipping periodically, or until bacon is crispy and meat is cooked through.
7. Let dove poppers cool before serving, and then enjoy!

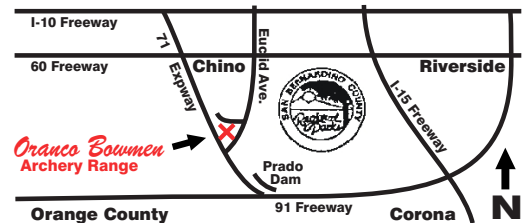

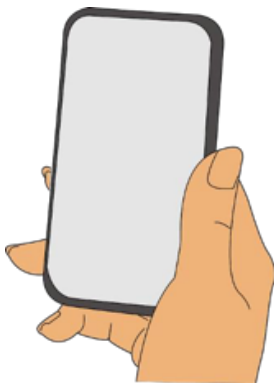

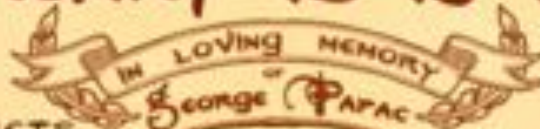
