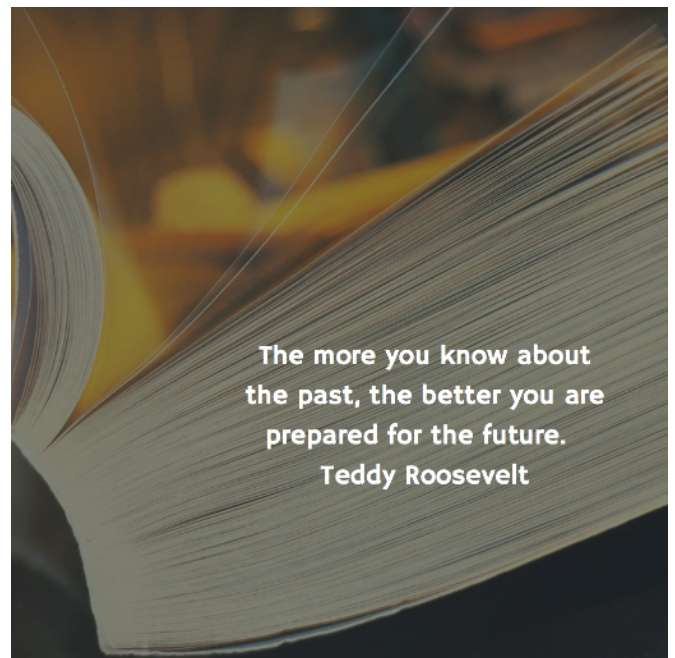

**FINALLY HUNTERS & FISHERMEN GET A BREAK!  
Important Please Read**

Dear California Bowmen Hunters and State Archery Association ,

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is expanding its Lands Pass Program (Program) to include 43 wildlife areas and ecological reserves where visitors must possess a lands pass while on the property, unless they are carrying their valid California hunting or fishing license. We are asking for your help in spreading the word to your members.

CDFW manages over 1 million acres of land, most of which is located on 247 ecological reserves and wildlife areas across the state. The majority of funding to manage these lands comes from hunters and anglers through a variety of federal and state programs.

The State Legislature directed CDFW to develop more income for land management from user fees by expanding the Program, which is currently implemented at six CDFW properties. In August 2016, after a lengthy public review process, the Fish and Game Commission voted to add an additional 37 properties.

In addition to visitors carrying their hunting or fishing license, visitors will be exempt from the lands pass requirement if they are under 16 years of age, or are part of a school or organized youth group field trip. This year, a daily lands pass costs \$4.32 and an annual Lands Pass costs \$24.33. Please note that a lands pass cannot be substituted for a hunting pass at a Type A or Type B wildlife area.

Lands passes will not be required until the properties have signs posted that explain the requirement. Properties that are new to the Lands Pass Program will be starting to require the passes between this coming November and January. We are preparing additional public outreach to notify the public before the requirement goes into effect.

Would you please distribute this information regarding the expansion of the lands pass requirement to your members? Arrows were flying fast and furious throughout the State in September as 11 clubs hosted the State Target Tournament or 900 Round. Over 400 archers competed in this tournament, an increase of archers over last years' tournament. Thank you to all the host clubs – BMB, Central Coast Archery, Impact Archery, Lodi Bowmen, Nevada Sportsmens, Oranco Bowmen, Salinas Bowmen, San Diego Archers, San Francisco Archers, Santa Ynez Archers, and Straight Arrows.

For the past 2 years, I have visited some of the host sites. This year, I had the pleasure of visiting 3 clubs: Black Mountain Bowmen, my home club in San Jose; Central Coast Archery in Arroyo Grande/San Luis Obispo Area; and Straight Arrows in Redding. I hope to visit 3 different sites next year.

Black Mountain Bowmen (BMB) club has archers shooting from a tree-lined flat area. Most of the archers competing were in the adult or older category. On Saturday, we had 2 youth competing, Lilith Pierce and Evan Elliott. Both archers are phenomenal. Lilith took champion in Y F BB and Recurve style. She also broke the State Record in the Youth Recurve Division. Evan took first place in Male Youth-FS division. I have watched Lilith and Evan evolve into the amazing archers they are today. Central Coast Archers hosted the State 900 over 2 weekends. I had the pleasure of seeing archers from Cub division to Master Senior division compete on a cool morning in September. Scott Wilson organized the event so that it ran smoothly. I met three young gals shooting Female Youth FS, Bella Otter, Sami Anderson, and Makena Ibay. Although all three were competing against each other, you could see that they were friends enjoying the sport of archery.

I was able to hitch a ride to Straight Arrows in Redding. The drive took about 5 hours in unbelievable traffic. I have not ever shot at Straight Arrows so I didn't know what to expect regarding their range. Pam Severtson showed me around. I was truly amazed at the size of their range. Their members had set up the 900 Tournament to the left of the cook shack (for those of you who have been to the range). They had expanded the field to accommodate the targets. Heather Tucker did an incredible job of organizing and running the tournament. I met many archers whose names were familiar to me but I hadn't met them. It was nice putting a name and face together.

Although I didn't visit Oranco Bowmen this year, Oranco continues to break attendance records for this tournament. Oranco Bowmen had 102 archers competing over 2 days! A huge Thank You to Chriss Bowles for an outstanding job of organizing this event.

# Bella Otter

My name is Bella Otter and I competed in the State 900 Round this last Sunday, Sept. 17. First of all, I just wanted to say thank you for coming to our tournament, and I really appreciated how you helped my target members and I with our score cards. I heard you mention that you would like emails about our archery story. I thought about it and here is mine:

Since the very first arrow, I fell in love with archery. Now, three and a half years later, I love it just as much. It was the summer of 2013 when I first caught archery fever. From 5 yards away, with a cheap recurve bow, we were shooting balloons at a Girl Scout day camp. We didn't have finger tabs, so my fingers ached when I drew. It was taking quite a while for anyone in our troop to get it closer than the six ring, until I popped mine first. The unexpected crack startled me, but not as much as the burning desire to do it again, and again, and again, even though my fingers were bright red.

Time passed, and I hadn't given archery another thought, until the 5th grade, when, all of a sudden, ALL I wanted was a bow for Christmas. To this day I still don't know what triggered a fierce longing for a bow of my own, but that Christmas, a Vortex bow showed up under our tree. I was ecstatic, and the adventure began. I was mostly just shooting in our backyard with my dad, but then he caught wind of a small, family owned archery shop in San Luis Obispo that was just beginning, called Central Coast Archery. Now we were shooting with a great group of people who shared our same passion, and soon we were accepted into the CCA family, including my amazing mentors, Scott, Joel, and Kaitlynd Wilson. A year after getting my own bow, I entered their JOAD class. It felt amazing to have a coach that focused on me personally, but also to be working as a team. As the small shop grew, so did my desire to continue what I loved, and take it to a whole new level, so I started entering tournaments. I started small, by going to the local "across the street" tournaments put on by Central Coast Archery. With the amazing coaching and support from CCA and my family, last year I became the state champ and record holder for the CBH State 900 round, and am ranked 14th in U S A Archery J O A D Nationals. Since then, as part of Team

CCA, with my PSE SupraMax formally owned by my JOAD mentor Kaitlynd in hand, I've gone to regional, state, and national tournaments. To me, archery is way more than holding a bow, drawing back, aiming, and firing arrows into the center for the sole purpose of getting a good score. Archery is feeling the bow, passion, dedication, practice, focus, family, and fun. Not only have I made great connections with the people at Central Coast Archery, who continue to encourage and support me, but I've also made family connections. Now I've spread the archery fever to my dad, sister, uncle, and grandpa, who all got their bows from Central Coast Archery, and give me their unwavering support and love. We can all come together and practice something that each of us has a passion for, and together, we are going beyond the paper target, and moving toward hunting to provide wild-game for family dinner. Having both relationships, one with my CCA family for the paper target, and one with my hunting family has exposed me to all the aspects of archery. Now I continue to strive to be better in each, even if it means just shooting some balloons.

# Lilith Pierce

About four years ago I went to a summer camp when I was seven years old, and they had archery there. When I came home, I told my parents the one thing I really liked at the camp was archery. So they signed me up for a basic introduction to archery class at an indoor range near my house in San Jose. The coach there had been taught by Mike Pierce from Predator's Archery, and I spent the next year

learning the fundamentals of archery before he took us to the Bug Shoot at Mount Madonna. I had a really good time and I wanted to keep on doing competitions. In the three years that I've been shooting,

I've done a lot of travel and competed in a lot of different kinds of tournaments. I don't really have one tournament that is my favorite, but I like field archery better than target archery because you shoot a lot of different distances, the set up and targets are always different, and a lot of the times it's like hiking in the mountains or the woods. I have also met a lot of really nice people from all over the country from places like North Carolina, Louisiana, Texas, Washington, Hawaii, and Wyoming.

Another thing I really like about archery is shooting well and getting better. And even though it seemed like things started pretty easy for me, I have been struggling with my anchor for the last year or so. I'm still working really



hard on that and I feel like I am getting back to where I was shooting well as a cub, except now I'm shooting as a youth. I started shooting the youth distances in June, a few months before I turned 12, and I really like shooting the farther distances. My dad keeps reminding me that because I shoot traditional recurve and don't use a sight or clicker, I shouldn't be so hard

on myself. But every time I shoot I always feel like I can do better. Which is what I want to do. Keep getting better.

There have been a lot of people who have been very helpful to me, and I know I won't be able to list them all, but I feel like I should at least thank everyone at Predator's Archery especially Mike Pierce, everyone at Black Mountain Bowmen especially Karen Keating, Becky Nelson-Harris, Thom Chamberlain, Gary & Sandy McCain, and Kelly & Alan Eagleton. There are lots of other archers and their families that I have really enjoyed shooting with at different clubs in the Mission Trails region and in a lot of other regions in the state.

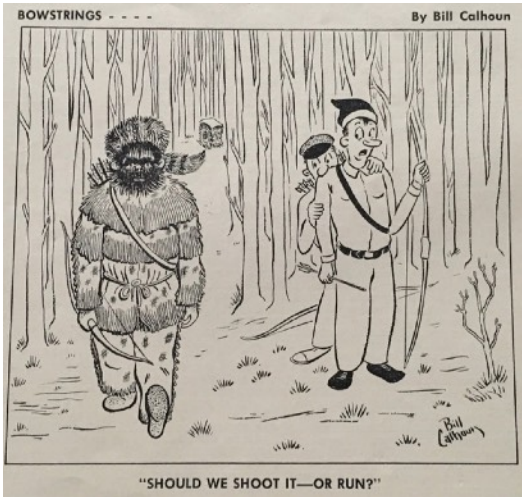
**Legislative Report by Robert Moore**

A California Fish and Game Commission meeting (CFGF) was held October 11 and 12<sup>th</sup> in Atascadero. Agenda item, 4. Wildlife Resources Committee (A) September 2017 meeting summary I. Receive and adopt recommendations (B) Work plan development I. Update on work plan and draft timeline II. Discuss and approve new topics, 6 Discuss proposed changes to sport fishing regulations (Sections 1.05, 1.11, 1.18, 1.61, 1.74, 2.10, 2.25, 5.35, 5.41, 5.88, 7.00, 7.50 and 8.00; repeal Section 1.60; and add Section 2.05, Title 14, CCR), we are seeking a change to 2.25 for bowfishing, Gaines and Associates provided comment. 7. Discuss proposed changes to regulations for the use of GPS-equipped dog collars and treeing switches for dogs used to pursue/take mammals or for dog training (Section 265, Title 14, CCR) 13. Non-marine petitions for regulation change from previous meetings (A) Action on petitions for regulation change – none scheduled at this time (B) Action on pending regulation petitions referred to staff and the Department for review I. Petition #2015-009 to raise commercial trapping license fees, FGC staff recommends that FGC deny the request as it requires a legislative change. Fish and Game Code does not define a commercial trapping license. Fish and Game Code Section 4006(a) only differentiates between resident, non-resident, and junior licenses. In addition, FGC is lacking evidence that all reasonable administrative and implementation costs of DFW and FGC are not currently being fully recovered; an assessment is necessary to make that determination and has been identified as a need for future action. II. Petition #2016-028 to clarify fire service members authorized to validate deer and elk tags, DFW enforcement grant request for consideration

The next FGC meeting will be December 6th and 7th in San Diego.

Predator Policy Workgroup, Region 1 rep, Teri Faulkner is a member of the review group to the proposals of the working group actions. From her last report the working group couldn't reach a complete consensus to policy change. FGC want's closure on this topic and if the group can't reach an agreement by the next commission meeting, the members can submit letters on the conflict and their recommendations.

# My Tombstone Hunt

## Hugh Rich Forest Lawn Cemetery

*Yes, the Game Wardens held the spotlights while we did the shooting.*

One of my most unusual hunts was a depredation hunt just minutes from Hollywood's famous Sunset Boulevard and the Beverly Hills Hotel. My early days of getting involved with bowhunting, started in 1949 B.C. (Before Compounds) in the Stockton, California area. Doc Smalley was one of my mentors and we enjoyed many hunts together. I not only learned a lot about bowhunting, but the importance of organized archery, and the job the NFAA and the California Bowman Hunters Association was doing for our sport.

Doc was elected president of CBH in 1956 and I went in with him as his vice president. During those early days there wasn't very many archery shops around, so Doc bought most of his archery equipment from **Hugh Rich Archery** in Southern California. Hugh was one of the west's biggest distributors and had a fantastic archery shop that catered to not only the bowhunters in the Southern California area, but also by mail order throughout the west. During those days the film studios would order thousands of arrows and hundreds of bows that Hugh made on special order, everything from the King Arthur days to the Indian-type bows and arrows. Hugh supplied just about everything for those early films. Howard Hill also worked for the studios and, as everybody knows, worked with Errol Flynn on the Robin Hood movie.

This was one of Hugh Rich's favorite stories and one he liked to tell at various banquets.

Hugh was well known in the Los Angeles and Hollywood area and when the Fish and Game Department called him it went something like this:

"Hey, Hugh, we have a deer problem out at the Forest Lawn Cemetery." There was a lot of open country back then surrounding Griffith Park and the famous Forest Lawn Cemetery. The Fish and Game Department then went on to say, "They couldn't use guns because it was practically down-

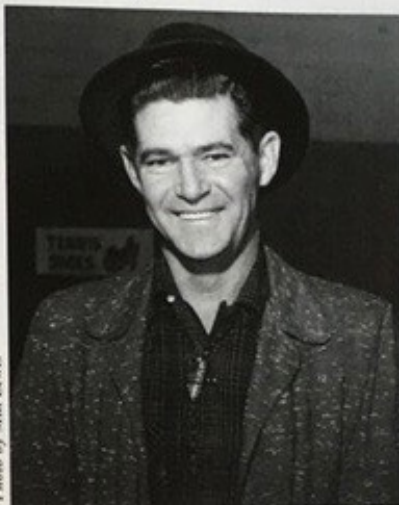

town Hollywood, they didn't want to use poison or traps 'cause that could be too dangerous, so they figured to give Hugh a chance to get some help for a depredation hunt, but he had to keep it **low key**." They didn't want the media or anyone to know about it. Well, since local bowhunters might just talk too much, Hugh figured to get some 'out of towners', that's why he phoned Doc Smalley, 500 miles away in Stockton. Doc asked if he could bring one hunter with him. I didn't know Hugh at that time, during this time through the 1950s. I was a Casualty Adjustor for a large insurance company and raising a family, so it was hard getting time off during week days, but my Claims Manager gave me the days off and before I knew it I was on my way with Doc Smalley down to Hugh's archery shop in Southern California.

After we got checked into a motel, we met Hugh at his shop. Hugh had a favorite hang-out, they called it "Damon's Steak House" and that's where we ended

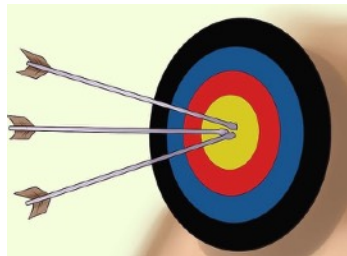

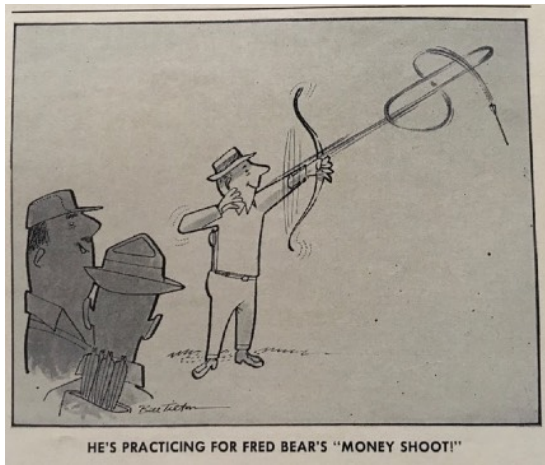

up with Hugh and one of the local Fish and Game guys to discuss just how all this was going to work. Well, later that night, we all met in front of the huge iron-gated entranceway to Forest Lawn. They had 3 pickup trucks there and some big portable lights. They said they would just ease into Forest Lawn and cruise around and see what happens. They explained the big problem the keepers of Forest Lawn had was that they were receiving complaints from mourners coming to the cemetery—they would leave big bouquets of beautiful flowers and then later find that the flowers had completely disappeared and had been eaten by the deer. Also the deer were working on some of Forest Lawn's prized shrubbery and greenery.

Doc got into the head truck with Hugh Rich and one of the Fish and Game guys and I got into the second truck and the third truck followed. I don't think we were on the grounds more than 15 minutes and I saw Hugh shoot a deer, then Doc got one. By this time the Fish and Game guy, that was with me, turned off and drove towards another area. I remember driving down between two mausoleums and just making a turn and there was this deer. We pulled up pretty close and with the Game Warden holding the spotlight on the deer, I got a good arrow off for a good hit, but they wouldn't let me get out of the back of the truck and they soon came back, dragging the deer behind them and loaded it up in the back of the third truck bed. Soon after that I missed a shot, the deer seemed to jump my bowstring and besides this kind of shooting was new to me. Shortly after that I saw a small buck run behind a big headstone and disappear. As we approached the area with the truck, the deer seemed to stick its head up over a headstone and none of us in the truck could keep from laughing, as it had part of a bouquet of flowers sticking out of its mouth and just stared at us. I got myself together and made my shot. The deer only took a few steps and fell. As I said, the Fish and Game guys wouldn't let us out of the pickup, they insisted on going after all the animals that we hit and returning them to the Fish & Game trucks themselves. They also said they would dispense with the carcasses — and that was that. We all arrowed some more deer, it was past midnight, so we called it a day (or night) and we went back through the front gates and drove off.

The Game Warden dropped us off at the parking lot by Hugh's shop and we decided to go back to Damon's Steak House to compare notes. All three of us accounted for nine deer. I'll have to confess — we did a little celebrating over a great steak. Hugh Rich had a bunch of friends there, they were all cowboy studio bit players at the time. Dameon's was not only a hang out for cowboys and bit players, but also stunt men, so it was always a real lively place in the evening. We had a great time.

The next day Doc and I left our motel and headed for Hugh's shop. Hugh disappointedly told us the rest of the hunt was called off — seems the caretaker found a couple of bloody arrows and blood trails around the area and that was that. Well, what else was there to do, we went back to Damon's for lunch, said our good-byes and then drove back to Stockton.

Later in the 1960s, when I was working for Fred Bear, Hugh and I would spend a lot of time together and we sure reminisced about this unusual hunt. Yes, we did the shooting and the Fish and Game Wardens held the spotlights and retrieved the deer. No one told Hugh what happened after that, but the deer herd dropped in numbers someway and Forest Lawn and Griffith Park ceased to have a deer problem.

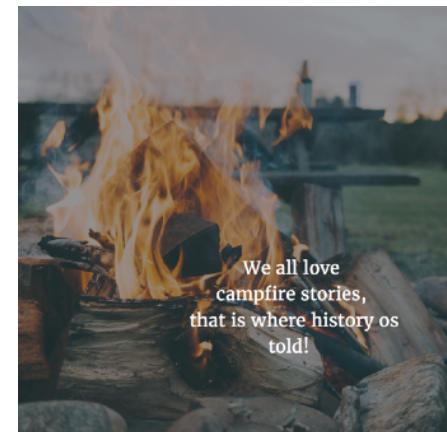
