CDFW Releases Draft Gray Wolf Conservation Plan

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has released the draft Conservation Plan for Gray Wolves in California and is soliciting input about the draft.

The plan is the product of collaboration between CDFW scientific and wildlife experts, and a diverse stakeholder group that has spent many hours since 2012 to develop it. The group includes Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, Natural Resources Defense Council, California Farm Bureau Federation, Defenders of Wildlife, California Woolgrowers Association, California Deer Association, California Cattlemen's Association and the Center for Biological Diversity, among others.

Interested parties are encouraged to review CDFW's website with information about gray wolves in California, including the legal status of wolves under federal and state law, the migration of the first documented wolf in the state in nearly 100 years and CDFW's announcement about the Shasta pack this summer. The website also features procedures for contacting CDFW for those who may experience wolves in the wild.

Informational workshops will be held to provide information and hear views about the plan in early 2016. All meetings will be held from 5-8 p.m. Dates and locations are as follows:

President's Message-by Wayne Raupe

As you read this we are already moving into February, the 2nd month of 2016! I can't even believe it! Time is just blasting by. As I write this in December we have yet held any of the CBH/SAA State Indoor Championship tournaments but they are just around the corner. However by the time you get this issue of the Magazine those tournaments will just be a fond memory and I hope an experience you will hold as a test of your abilities. A test in which you reached your goal of being the State Champion! I sincerely hope you accomplished that. Also just a reminder that you have the chance to walk away with the CBH/SAA Grand Slam Award if you succeed in being the Champion of all four of our State Tournaments. However you must accomplish this goal all in back to back

tournaments within any 12 month period. That is... if you are an adult and you are a Champion in the State Field, the State 900, the State Indoor and the State Broadhead you qualify for the Grand Slam Award. If you are a Cub you only need to win three of the four State Championships as Cubs are not eligible to participate in the State Broadhead Championship Tournaments.

I know you are all anxious to find out how you fared in the tournament compared to your competition so your question to me is... When will the scores come out in the Magazine? I wish I had an easy answer for you but the truth be told it is dependent upon several factors. But the bottom line is that your 2nd VP of Indoor, Rusty Mills, must get your score cards from the host sites and the scores and all of your information on the card must legible and correct. Once Rusty receives the cards he must add up each of your scores to confirm your final score then rank you and your competition to determine who placed and who the champion is. If all of this can be done in a timely fashion Rusty could at the very earliest have the scores in the March issue. However, the scores will most likely be in the April issue or as soon as possible.

Your CBH/SAA Secretary, Pam Severtson, will have the minutes from the Annual Meeting in the Magazine as soon as she can get them transcribed. Please read them as they will tell you what your organization is doing and what it is doing for you.

Your Legislative Team is working... a never ending endeavor... to increase hunting and bowfishing opportunities. Currently we are working on getting DFG & DFW to legalize the taking of catfish with a bow and arrow. This will NOT be statewide but rather in specific waters. More to follow on that later so watch for your CBH/SAA Legislative Coordinator, Robert Moor's reports and articles. Also, at the Dec 10th, 2015, DFG Commission Meeting the DFW elk biologist provided an extensive report on the condition of California's elk herd and it was very positive. The recommendation from the Biologists was to increase the number if elk to be taken this coming season and the Commissioners were supportive of that recommendation. However, with that being said I will not be surprised if none of this increase in the number of take equal any more elk tags for the archers. DFW allocates the number of tags to the archers and the gun hunters based upon the ratio of general applications vs. archery applications so even though I asked for more tags at the Commission Meeting I am not expecting much.

On another issue... Our proposal to DFG to change the DFG Regulations so that it will be legal for bowhunters to use conventionally fetched arrows for shooting migratory birds while they are on the water or land is currently under consideration by DFW Enforcement. We are in hopes that they will work with us and change the Regulations. If we are successful however, remember that you will still be required to use flu flu arrows while shooting at them in flight. Watch for details coming from Robert Moore.

I hope you all had a wonderful Christmas and a happy New Year!! I wish each of you only the very best in this coming year... and if you just happen to win the lottery please remember me.... well you know. :-)

Bret Scott told me to let you all know that the Tilapia Tournament will be held on the 14th and 15th of May in Palo Verde and the Carp Tournament will be on the 4th and 5th of June at Lake Isabella. See you all there.

I started this message yesterday while getting a crown in the dentist chair and am finishing it while on my way to Arizona to hunt Javelina so I hope it is readable and makes sense.

Legislative Information

Legislative Information

The next Fish and Game Commission (FGC) meeting held February 10 & 11 in Sacramento. No agenda has been posted at this writing. Comment period on mammal regulations continues till the Commissions April meeting. Additionally there is continued discussion and selection of persons to the WRC predator management working group.

The next Wildlife Resources meeting was to be held January 20th in Sacramento. This meeting has been cancelled.

The 2016 Legislative Cycle will begin January/February. Bills submitted last year that was granted 2 years to complete will have action or defeated. New bills can also be introduced but must be completed this year.

Bills to watch: and current positions.

AB499 Cooley, amend Fish and Game Code 4370, archery season in regards to Concealed firearms permit holders. To meet legislative deadline, AB 499 must be heard in Senate Natural Resources and Water Committee by April 22nd.

AB290 Bigelow, amend Fish and Game Code 3953, Big Game Account related to pigs. At their October 8th meeting, the California Fish and Game Commission made it clear that they

have no intention at this time to make any changes to current wild pig regulations. As such, expect activity on AB 290 to ramp up immediately after the New Year. To remain viable in the second year of the two-year Session, AB 290 will have to be heard in Assembly Policy Committee by January 15th. In the meantime, Gaines & Associates is working closely with Assembly Member Bigelow and his staff this fall to address the concerns of our clients.

AB665 Frazier, amend Fish and Game Code 203.1 and add sections 200.5 & 200.6, clarifies authority to Fish and Game Commission on Hunting and Fishing. To meet legislative deadline, AB 665 must be heard in Assembly Appropriations Committee and passed to the Floor by January 22nd.

AB395 Gallagher, amend Fish and Game Code 3004.5, Lead ammunition, eliminate phase in wording. AB 395 will have to be heard in Assembly Policy Committee by January 15th to remain viable in 2016.

CBHSAA lobbyist, Bill Gaines through his special reports will keep us informed on the above bills and any that may be modified later. His Special Reports will be posted on the CBHSAA website under legislative link and distributed to legislative reps that I have email addresses for.

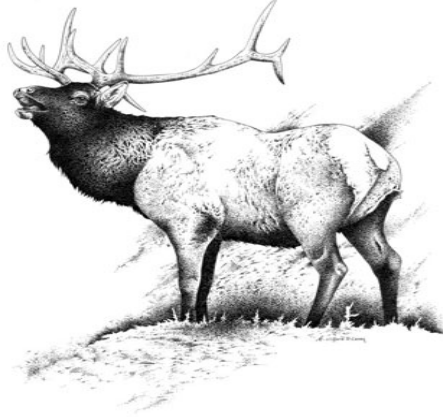

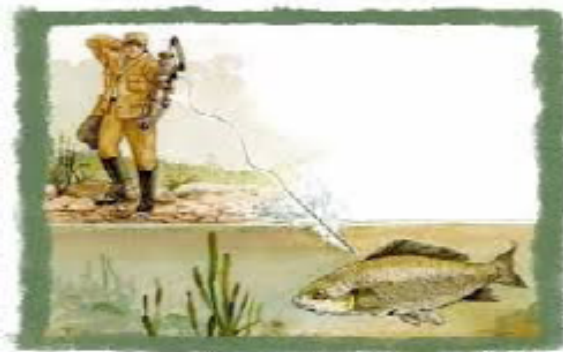
