The State 3-D (Unmarked) Championship Tournament shall be a one or two day event and shall be governed by the 2nd-Vice-President in charge of Hunting, or his appointed representative *Legislative Defense Team*. The date of the tournament shall be selected by the host club/region. The host club/region shall have the option of "piggy-backing" the tournament in conjunction with an existing tournament.

- 13) DUTIES OF THE 2ND-VP HUNTING LEGISLATIVE DEFENSE TEAM:
- e) Arrange for inspection of host club/region range no later than two (2) weeks prior to the tournament to ensure that the site is of adequate size and design to satisfy NFAA range inspection and safety requirements.
