Since online membership is available, clubs and shops are encouraged to use the online process which means the forms and payment no longer are sent to the CBH/SAA Secretary. The CBH/SAA Secretary obtains the monthly report from NFAA and updates the clubs and shops list from the online report. If clubs/shops still choose to send the form and payment to the CBH/SAA Secretary, these will be forwarded to NFAA for manual processing.

B.2. The NFAA fee is \$30 and the CBH/SAA fee is \$20. Fees to be payable to NFAA with payment and form to be sent to CBH/SAA Secretary for processing. Clubs and shops are encouraged to use an online account with NFAA for processing their NFAA charter. However, they may still print the form and send to the CBH/SAA Secretary with the appropriate payment and will be forwarded to NFAA.

ADD:

Clubs/shops hosting any CBH/SAA State Tournament are to have a current range inspection on file with NFAA. If a competing round (example; 900 Round) does not have an inspection available, a current "Field", "Outdoor" or "Bowhunter" range inspection will suffice.
