To add clarity and consistency in the communication within each region, we would like to add the following guidelines. This will help increase the knowledge of each region of their expectation and participation in CBH/SAA & NFAA matters.

6. The regional president, will send a copy of all the NFAA petitions to each of their regional clubs, at least 30 days before the Executive Committee meeting (also known as Presidents' Meeting). This will give clubs time to discuss with their membership the proposals and provide feedback to the regional president ahead of the meeting.
7. The regional president, will send a copy of all the CBH/SAA petitions to each of their regional clubs, at least 60 days before the Annual Meeting (typically held in February). This will give clubs time to discuss with their membership the proposals and provide feedback to the regional president ahead of the meeting.
8. Each region will provide yearly, an annual financial report to the clubs in their region and for the Annual Meeting, indicating how much the region has received from NFAA, how much has been received by other means, expenses (such as travel and board for regional leadership to meetings), as well any other expenses made, and the amount and to whom donations have been made if applicable.
9. Each regional president will hold at least one meeting annually, in person or online, with all the clubs in their region.
