Section H – CBH/SAA QUINTUPLE STATE TOURNAMENT AWARD

- This specially designed award shall be awarded to any archer who wins 5 State Championship Titles within 12 months in the same division and shooting style (e.g., gender, age class, and bow/arrow style). The archer must win the "Champion" title in each of the following State Championship Tournaments: Indoor, Field, Target, Marked 3D and Unmarked 3D. Note: The State Broadhead and State Traditional Tournaments are excluded because they do not follow the same age class and bow/arrow styles as these other tournaments.
- This award will be awarded at the CBH/SAA Annual State Meeting/Banquet.
