B. Shooting Divisions, and-Styles, and Para Archer Class. Divisions: Master Senior, Silver Senior, Senior, Adult, Young Adult, Youth, Cub & Pro.

Styles in Adult, Senior, Silver Senior & Master Senior: Barebow, Bowhunter Freestyle, Freestyle, Freestyle Limited, Freestyle Limited Recurve, Traditional and Barebow Recurve.

Para Archer Class will be split into four classes, "ST", "W2", "W1", and "B". "ST", standing, has a disability that can affect either the upper body or lower body, but they stand or sit on a stool or chair to shoot (feet are on the ground). "W2" will have paraplegia or comparable disability. This class will display minimal or no limitations in upper body strength, range of motion or coordination. W2 athletes may shoot from a wheelchair and compete in either compound or recurve open category. "W1" shoot from a wheelchair but have more severe impairments than W2. To be classified as W1, an archer must have impairments in at least 3 limbs and the core and must shoot using a wheelchair. "B" for visually impaired archers.

Styles in Barebow Recurve will include Adult and Senior only.

Styles in Young Adult, Youth & Cub: Barebow, Bowhunter Freestyle, Freestyle & Freestyle Limited Recurve. Style in Professional: Freestyle. Professional Divisions include: Adult, Senior, Silver Senior & Master Senior.

In CBH/SAA State Shoots, there will be 2 categories for Longbow the following rules will apply; Longbow-wood and Longbow any arrow. Longbow shooters archers shoot the youth distance out to 50 yards.

Longbow division will include age groups; Adult, Senior, Silver Senior and Master Senior.

In CBH/SAA State Shoots, there will be 2 categories for Recurve—Recurve off the shelf, which includes the elevated rest, plunger and 12" stabilizer and the Traditional Recurve.

For the Traditional Recurve, CBH/SAA will recognize the Recurve-off the shelf, the following rules apply;

- 1. This style is for recurve bows that are shot from the shelf with no elevated rest.
- 2. No device of any kind that can be used for sighting shall be allowed in the sight window.
- 3. There shall be no mechanical or other device in the sight window except the arrow.
- 4. The only foreign material allowed in the sight window will be felt, Velcro or leather on the side and shelf oth the bow. The side plate shall be no higher than 1/4" above the arrow that is used.
- 5. No clickers, draw checks, grip sears, weights or levels will be allowed. No marks or blemishes on the face of the bow or in the sight window will be allowed. No stabilizer.
- 6. During a round no adjustments may be made to the bow and/or its related equipment.
- 7. Vertical bow quivers are permissible.
- 8. The string is allowed to be colored, but the center serving must be a uniform color or pattern. Brush buttons and string silencers may be used. Any marks or string attachments shall be illegal.
- 9. One anchor point only is permitted, no face or string walking will be allowed.
- 10. The archer shall touch the arrow nock with the index finger when drawing the arrow. Finger position shall not change during competition.
- 11. Glove, tabs or fingers shall be the only release devices deemed legal. Unless physical disability of the arms or hands, a chew strap may be used in place of fingers.
- 12. All arrows shall be identical in length, weight, diameter and fletching with allowance for wear and tear.
- 13. No written memorandum will be allowed.
- 14. No device for measuring distance and/or gap shall be allowed.
- 15. Maximum distance for this class shall be 50 yards.
- 16. Recurve-off the shelf division will include age groups; Adult, Senior, Silver Senior and Master Senior. (3/23)

## C. Para Archers

- 1. Para archers will compete in all CBH/SAA age divisions and bow styles. Para archers will compete in either the , "ST", "W2", "W1", and "B" class.
- 2. Para archers will be required to have eligibility determined by an organization such as USA Archery, or by a physician familiar with the applicant's medical condition, disease, or injury and who must sign the completed document and provide national medical society or board of practice information for verification purposes.
- 3. CBH/SAA will provide at least one competition site that is para archer friendly for the State Indoor Championship, State Field Championship, and the State Target Championship. The State Target Championship will be modified to a one day format: 14 Field Round targets, 14 Animal Round targets, and 14 Hunter Round targets.

The California State Field Championship Tournament shall be a one-stage tournament to be scheduled on the weekend of the second Sunday in June each year. The Tournament shall consist of 28Field and 28 Animal on Saturday and 28 Hunter targets to be shot on Sunday. The targets and shooting distances will comply with NFAA regulations. The multi site State Field may be held as an option. The format is one day; 14 field, 14 hunter and 14 animal and will be held in the month of June. The State Field for para archers to compete may be held at a separate time, such as outside the month of June, and place so as to be more para archer friendly.

- 2. This award will be awarded at the CBH/SAA Annual State Meeting/Banquet as to give honor to the all around champion.
- 3. Cubs shall be ineligible for this award as they do not compete in the Broadhead Tournament.

## **CUB GRAND SLAM AWARD**

This specially designed award shall be awarded to any cub archer who wins the 3 State Championship Tournaments; Indoor, Field and Target within a 12 month period, shooting in one style.

The cub archer must win the "Championship" title in each state event.

This award would be awarded at the CBH/SAA Annual State Meeting/Banquet as to give honor to the all around Champion. (Rev 1/08)

## PARA ARCHER GRAND SLAM AWARD

This specially designed award shall be awarded to any para archer who wins the 3 State Championship Tournaments; Indoor, Field and Target within a 12 month period, shooting in one style.

The para archer must win the "Championship" title in each state event.

This award would be awarded at the CBH/SAA Annual State Meeting/Banquet as to give honor to the all around Champion.
