Team, it's been a quiet summer so far. Hopefully, others drew better big game tags than I did. Hunting has certainly been on the slow side for me. Local fires have definitely slowed a lot of people down here in southern California. It does look like NorCal folks may have had some better success. Congratulations to everyone who harvested, and make sure to get in touch with the CBH/SAA Big Game Club and get your animal measured. It may not be a record breaker, but it's fun to go through the process and gives you some insight into how BGC, and Pope&Young operate.

For those of you harvesting small game and chasing that Golden Eagle Trophy, get in touch with any BGC committee member and turn in your species. It may take a while to get there, but it's always neat to see a person get that trophy at the banquet! The BGC has a lot going on right now, and we are zeroing in on a location for next year's broadhead. More from Bret later in the newsletter.

As for me, I got in a nice dove hunt to open the season. I spent three productive days with my Hunter Education team in Yuma, AZ. It was hotter than hell, but there were plenty of birds in the areas we tried. Limit 2 out of three days!...and some bad shooting on the third. Speaking of Hunter Education, be advised that the On-Line Hunter Education that was being offered by CDFW has now been eliminated. There is no longer any online support for Hunter Ed. Please plan ahead with your kids or grandkids and any other people that you are getting started. With no more online, you will need to get into a traditional class somewhere. With the retirement of a lot of HEI, there are not nearly as many classes available as there once were. Space and availability may be limited. Don't wait until the



last minute. Soon most people should have the results of the State 900. Thanks to Tere Johnson for taking over as 2nd VP - Target and running this significant event. We had a good turnout this year, and I look forward to even better participation next. Sounds like we had a young shooter clean the round this year. This is the first time I heard of a perfect score in this shoot for California, so congratulations, and I look forward to a complete report from Tere when all the scores are in.

I really want to encourage everyone to participate in the upcoming State Unmarked 3D in November. This is the last shoot of the year and all proceeds will go to support our very important legislative efforts. I know Amanda

will have more on this going forward. Amanda will have a complete report in her legislative update but suffice it to say that we are making some good progress on Elk tags.

We also have some plans for bears moving forward in 2025. The Catalina deer issue is still ongoing. I will be heading to the island in early October to observe some research efforts sponsored by CBH and several other NGOs to see if there really is a problem as reported...more on that next month. The registration for State Indoor should be open by the time you read this. Make sure to get registered and shoot. It's a great warm-up for Vegas! Brian and I had a great conversation, and he assured me that awards and scores will be more timely this year as he is putting some tougher deadlines on everyone involved. There have been some issues over the years with host sites not getting scores in a timely fashion.

Legislative Committee Update

Greetings CBH/SAA Friends and Family!

We have some **OUTSTANDING** news to share! Thanks to our consistent efforts in partnership with Gaines and Associates, Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation (RMEF), and others, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is proposing to add up to 22 archery only elk tags in the 2025 Big Game Draw! The increase in tags is strongly supported by science, including the size of herds, potential habitat impacts as a result of Scott Dam removal, and levels of human-elk conflict. Bull and cow elk archery-only hunt opportunities are expected in Siskiyou, Central Coast, and La Panza Elk Management Units (EMUs). Also, keep an eye out for new General and SHARE hunt tags in Lake Pillsbury and Bear Valley EMUs. Details are available in CDFW's presentation at the September Wildlife Resource Committee (WRC) meeting here and are expected to be presented to the Fish and Game Commission (FGC) in December. CDFW also recognizes that more tags are warranted in other EMUs, but due to staffing constraints, the evaluation of these opportunities is deferred to 2025. CDFW hopes to hire a new Elk Coordinator to drive these efforts in the near future.

Registration for the **2024 State Unmarked 3D Championship** is OPEN! The tournament will be held **at Oranco Bowmen on Sunday, November 17.**

See the event flyer in this newsletter. We look forward to seeing you. Remember, proceeds from the event registration and raffle benefit the CBH Legislative Defense Fund.



SECTION A – Tournament Shooting Styles

Shooting Divisions and Styles.

Divisions: Master Senior, Silver Senior, Senior, Adult, Young Adult, Youth, Cub & Pro.

Styles in Adult, Senior, Silver Senior & Master Senior: Barebow, Bowhunter Freestyle, Freestyle, Freestyle Limited, Freestyle Limited Recurve, Traditional, Longbow aluminum/carbon, Longbow wood Recurve off the shelf & Barebow Recurve

Styles in Young Adult, Youth & Cub: Barebow, Barebow Recurve, Bowhunter Freestyle, Freestyle & Freestyle Limited Recurve, Longbow aluminum/carbon, Longbow wood and Recurve off the shelf & Traditional.

Style in Professional: Freestyle. Professional Divisions include: Adult, Senior, Silver Senior & Master Senior.

In CBH/SAA State Shoots, the following rules will apply; Longbow-wood and Longbow any arrow. Longbow archers shoot the youth distance out to 50 yards.

SECTION F: CBH/SAA STATE 3-D (UNMARKED) CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

(excerpts relevant to shooters)

GENERAL WORKING MECHANICS

- 1) This tournament will consist of a minimum of 42 life-sized animal targets at unmarked distances.
- 2) This tournament shall be a one-(1) arrow tournament.
- 3) Participants must be a NFAA/CBH/SAA member or a CBH/SAA Associate Member and a resident of the state of California or declared residency or have a reciprocal agreement with NFAA on file, at the time of registration to participate for awards.
- 6) In the case of a non-piggybacked tournament, the archers will be assigned a target to shoot with their competition. This will happen in the case of a 1-day tournament or a 2-day tournament.

8) SCORING:

- a) Scoring shall be: Inner Kill Ring = 10 points, Outside Vital Ring = 8 points, Balance of Animal = 5 points.
- b) Scoring on buck/doe combinations shall be as noted above for an arrow in the buck. A hit on the does shall be scored as 0 points.
- c) An arrow must remain in the animal to be scored.
- d) Skip-ins will not be scored.
- e) An arrow must touch the line to score in the higher scoring area.
- f) No mulligans or doe tags are permitted.
- g) Ties will be decided by a sudden death shoot-off.

9). DIVISIONS AND AWARDS:

- a) Shooting Divisions and Styles shall follow CBH/SAA Standing Rules Article I – Tournaments, Section A – Tournament Shooting Styles. (See Above)
- b) Awards will be First through Third Place in each division.
- d) A single guest division shall be set up for non-members of CBH/SAA. Shooters in this division shall not be eligible for awards.

12) PROTESTS: Protests will cost \$50.00. A protest can be filed, only by a registered archer of said tournament, or the parent/guardian if juvenile is going to protest, at any time during the tournament or within 30 minutes of conclusion of the shooting day. The 2nd V.P and/or designated Tournament Chairman will rule on the protest. If the protest is upheld, the fee will be refunded.


