Flu-Flu Arrows What are they, and why are they used? Andrew Mack (Small Game Club Chairman)


Everyone is familiar with the Standard arrow with three fletchings for normal targets or even when pursuing that big game animal of a lifetime.



But they are not as effective for small game mammals like a ground squirrel or a bird like a morning dove. For one main reason they fly too fast and can be lost with a small chance of recovery. That is where Flu-Flu arrows come in. They are way more effective, not only for taking down small game but also for an easier recovery. Flu-flu arrows are designed to fly straight for about 20-30 yards before rapidly slowing down and dropping, making them perfect for shooting at flying targets. The longer fletching will generate more drag and slow the Arrow down. Their short range is also perfect for hunting in forests or wooded areas. See the Flu-Flu arrow below.



You can see they have a special design of fletching that is made by using long sections of feathers. Most of the time six or more sections are used, rather than the normal three. (See Illustration B)



Special bird points are used that entangle the bird as it flies into a wire harness attached to the end of the arrow. As seen in (above). This type of arrow point is more effective for more open field hunting like for morning doves flying through a flat open farm field.

Judo Points (below) are recommended for small game, especially for shooting birds in flight or from trees. If you see how they have a blunt point so they won't stick in the wood of a tree. Besides birds, this type of arrow tip is also perfect for Squirrels or other game that live in trees. Judo Points are also very effective in grassy areas for hunting small ground game. The spring arms grab and tangle in vegetation and they help prevent the arrow from burying itself in the ground or getting lost. This makes arrow retrieval simple.

Another option is a Hex Head (Below). These are more popular with traditional Archers who need to maximize energy transfer at lower arrow speeds. They are designed to cut and crush small game on impact.



If you're in pursuit of Larger birds, such as geese, using broadheads is still recommended for a lethal hit, even at closer ranges.

Fixed blade broadheads (below) are also more effective for small game like raccoons, but they are not recommended for rabbits and squirrels. The blades will cause too much damage and overpenetrate, in turn, spoiling the meat.



In California, flu-flu arrows are legally required for hunting migratory game birds and pheasants with a bow and arrow. The one exception is for hunters taking waterfowl from a boat, possibly a scullboat, while the birds are on the water. In this specific situation, conventionally fletched arrows may be used.

Unlike most good hunting stories this starts at the very end.

Several years ago on my yearly archery hunting trip to Airzona. I had an unexplained encounter on the last morning of the ten-day hunt.

My hunting partner dropped me off at one of two ridges we usually glass from, where we'd often seen both whitetail and mule deer. He then continued on to the second ridge.

It took me about fifteen minutes to make my way in the dark to the lower end. I was just starting to hike toward the higher end to begin glassing when I saw it.

There was no sound—not even from my own footsteps—when, to my right, I became aware of something about five feet off the ground and only seven feet away, slowly passing by. It was disk-shaped, maybe a quarter-inch thick and about four to five inches across, with a medium gray color. It floated at a slight angle, the edge closest to me just a little lower.

It wasn't a bird gliding by. As it drifted about fifteen feet ahead of me, it simply disappeared. When I reached the exact spot where it vanished, there was nothing—no bushes, no cactus, nothing that could've hidden it.

When my friend came to pick me up several hours later, I told him what I'd seen. I think if we hadn't known each other for over fifty-five years,

he might've made me ride in the back of the truck on the way out.

To this day, even after hunting that same spot many times since, I still have no explanation for what it was.

So now I've got to ask—am I the only one who's had an unexplained experience out there?






